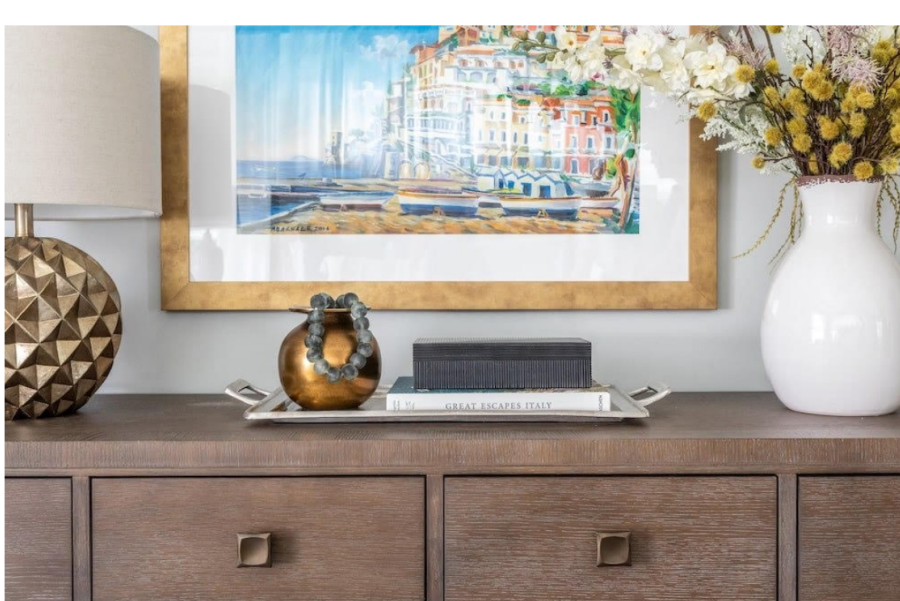

Insider Tips

If your ceilings are low and you want to give the illusion of a bigger space, paint your ceilings white to open up the room. Hang curtains above windows and doors to elongate the walls and make sure there is plenty of natural light to brighten the space.



Q&A: How high should I hang a painting or picture?

A: We usually say that artwork is hung at your average eye level height, meaning the center of the art is hung at approximately 60" high. If you're hanging art over a console or dresser, we usually hang it at 6"- 8" above the furniture piece. Of course, this is a general rule of thumb, and with every design "rule," there is a situation that breaks it. Have a tricky wall? Send us a photo for a future feature!
