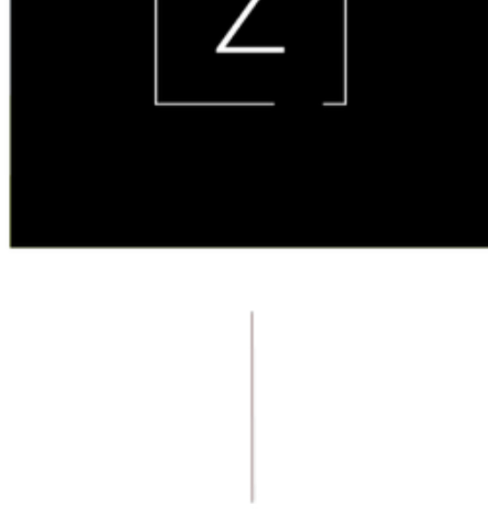

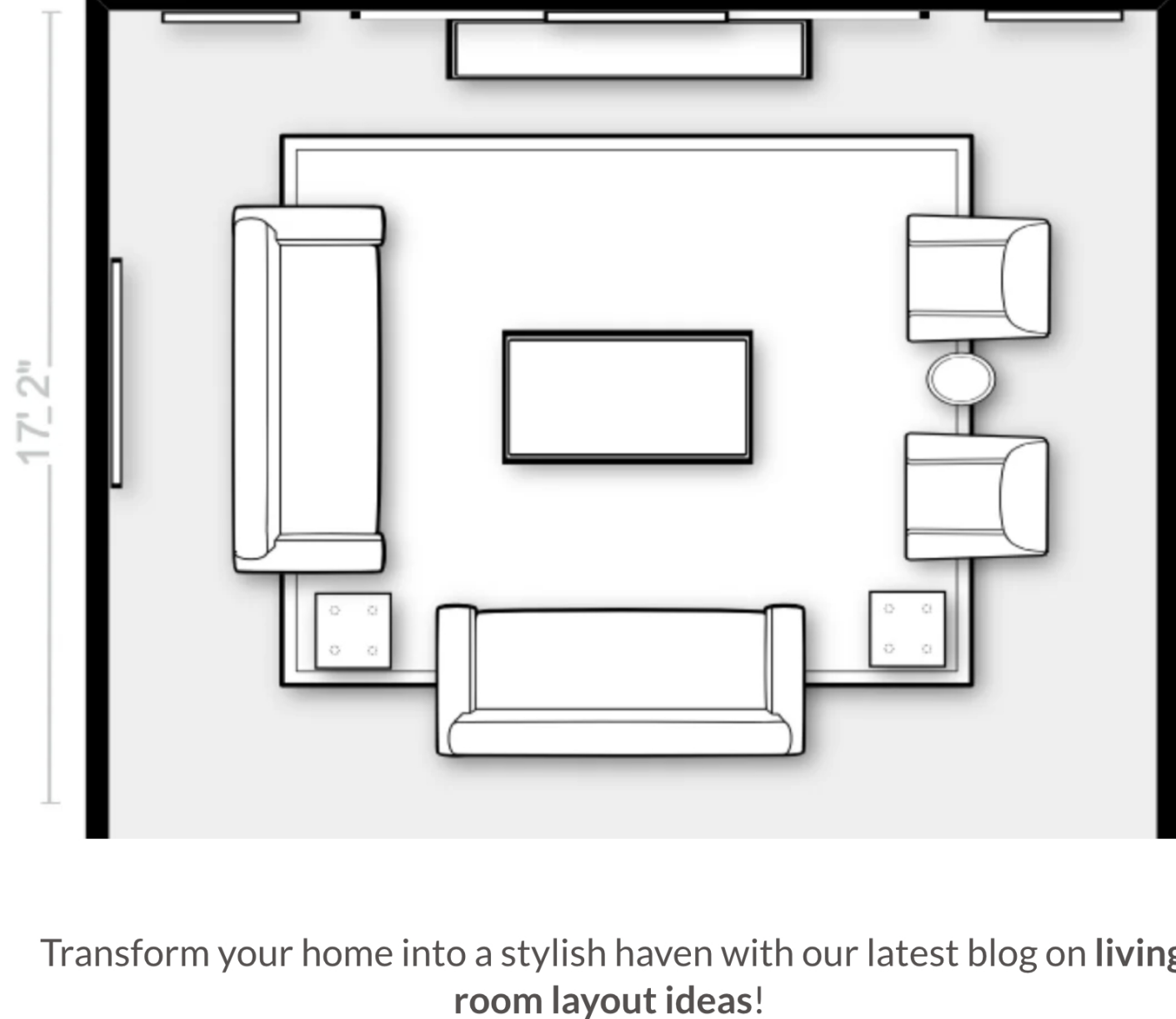

Color Drenching



Color drenching is a trend that involves enveloping a space in a single, bold color, extending it across walls, furniture, and even ceilings. This technique creates a cohesive and immersive environment, allowing for a dramatic visual impact. Popular colors for this trend include earthy tones, soft pinks, and deep blues.

INSIDER TIPS

Styling A Gallery Wall



When creating a gallery wall, start by selecting pieces of varying sizes and orientations to create visual interest. Mix frames, canvases, and textures for added depth. A common theme creates cohesion, but don't be afraid to mix different styles, like black-and-white photography with abstract art. Lay out your arrangement on the floor first, aiming for balance rather than perfect symmetry. A 2-5 inch space between each piece is recommended.

Any tips on selecting table lamps?

Prioritize height and scale to ensure they complement your furniture. Aim for a lamp height that places the bottom of the shade at eye level when seated, typically between 24 to 36 inches. For functionality, consider lamps with shades that direct light downwards for task lighting, while decorative lamps can provide a softer glow.
