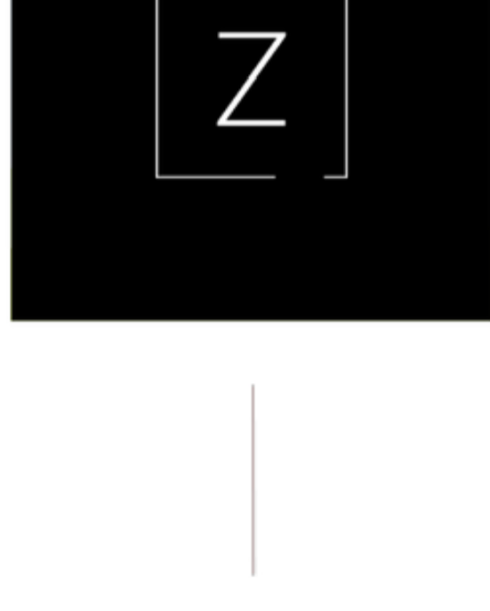

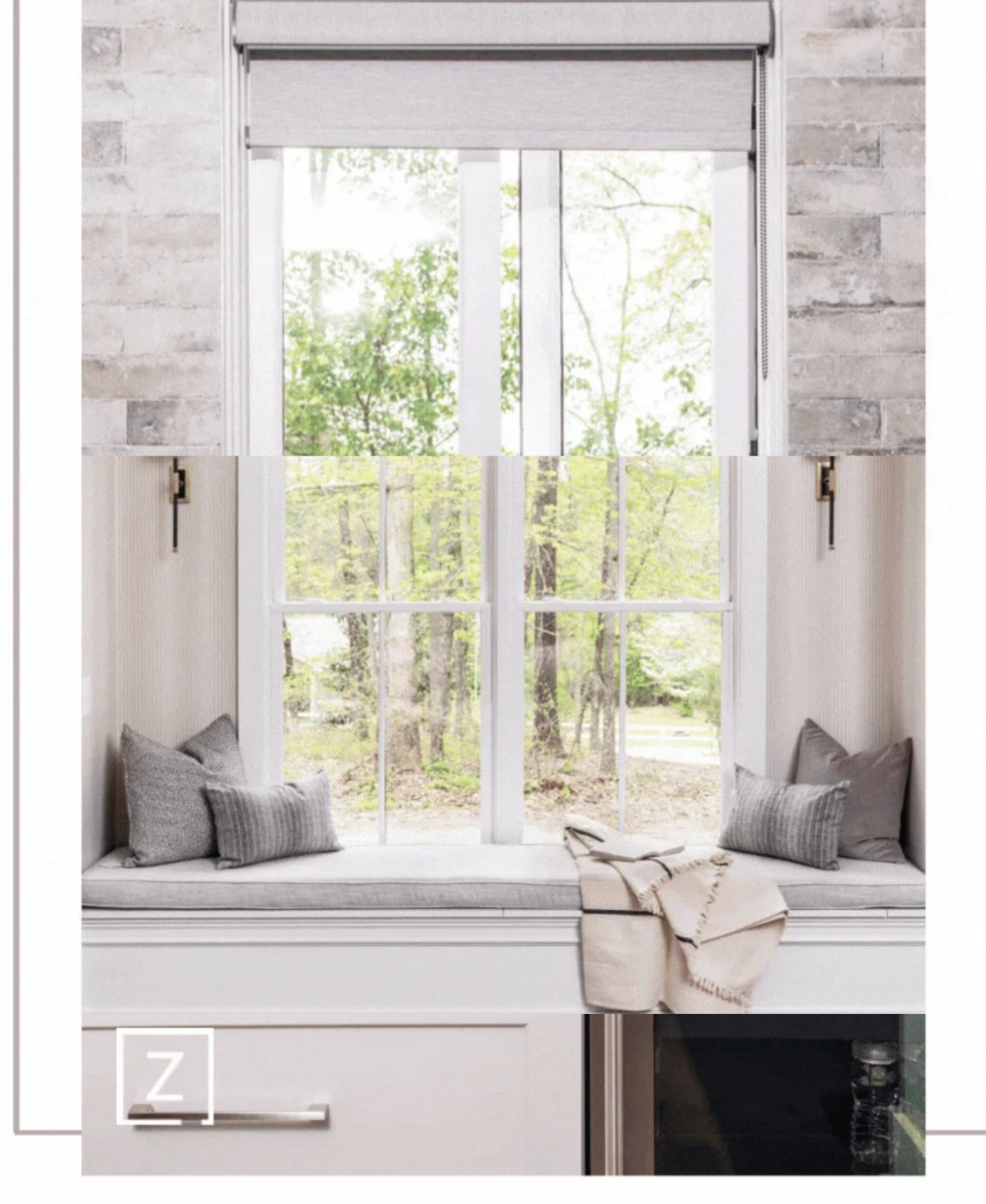
When to Paint Wood



When deciding whether to paint wood, high-quality wood with beautiful grain or antiques is often best left natural. If a piece uses multiple types of wood, painting is generally the better option, as different woods take stains differently. For intricate carvings or damage that can't easily be fixed, painting may be easier than restaining.

What to do if a window throws off the symmetry of a space?

You have a couple of options. You can use wall-to-wall curtains or extended curtain rods to create the illusion of a centered window. Or, consider custom built-ins to integrate the awkward window into the overall design. If you want to embrace the asymmetry, you can use striking fabrics or patterns to highlight the off-center window as a design feature.
